

#### **ELIGIBILITY**

This competition is open to all artists, 18 years of age and over, who presently live in Indiana or Ohio. Works must be original, completed in the last two years, and NOT PREVIOUSLY EXHIBITED IN ANY **REGIONAL** JUDGED OR JURIED SHOWS. Accepted works may **NOT** be withdrawn by the artist prior to the close of the exhibition and must abide by specifications below.

Both 2-D and 3-D works are eligible, including drawing, printmaking, mixed media, painting, photography, computer generated art, fiber arts, clay, jewelry, sculpture, wood and glass. Works must be original art produced by the submitting artist completed in 2022-2023. Advanced division artists' works cannot have been executed in class or under supervision of an instructor.

## **JURORS**

**Greg Hull** was appointed as dean of Herron School of Art and Design in 2021. His studio work and interests include interactive, kinetic, and time-based media including light, sound, and video. His work is exhibited in galleries, museums, and universities and public spaces nationally. Hull is an Efroymson Contemporary Arts Fellow, a two-time Creative Renewal Fellowship recipient, and one of two inaugural recipients of the Arts Council of Indianapolis' Transformational Impact Fellowship.

**Carol Ann Carter** is an interdisciplinary visual artist. Her work currently involves mixed media painting and construction, installation, digital imaging, performance, and video. She earned an M.F.A from The University of Notre Dame in 1974, and a B.F.A from The Herron School of Art of Indiana University in 1970. She has taught at Saint Mary's College, Notre Dame IN, Penn State University, The University of Michigan, and from 1996-2015, The University of Kansas Visual Art Department: painting, drawing, design foundations, and graduate studies.

#### **SPECIFICATIONS**

Each artist may submit a maximum of **two works**. All works must be maintenance-free. No entry may exceed 60 inches in any direction, including frame, or exceed 50 pounds in weight.

#### **FRAMING**

All wall-hung work must be properly framed. Frames without securely attached wire cannot be hung on our wall and will not be accepted. Vertical D Rings are the preferred hardware for hanging in the new RAM galleries. We will not be responsible for works damaged through faulty wiring or framing.

- Use flat strap wires only (no saw-tooth or clip frame hangers).
- Works on paper must be glazed.

## **INSURANCE AND LIABILITY**

RAM will provide insurance on all works while at the museum for the listed sales price. Values must be based on actual retail sales, subject to a maximum of \$5,000 for any one item. RAM will not assume liability for loss or damage during transit to and from the museum.

#### **SALES**

## **ALL WORKS IN ADVANCED DIVISION MUST BE**

**FOR SALE**. The Richmond Art Museum will retain a 30% commission. Prices listed on the entry form must reflect this commission. Purchase Awards will be paid at 70% of the listed price. Prices of accepted works may not change.

**AMATEUR DIVISION** Amateur artists are encouraged to enter the Amateur Division of the 125th Annual Exhibition by Indiana and Ohio Artists. Entry requirements are the same as listed above, however, works completed under supervision are eligible. An amateur is defined as an artist who is in their early stages of development, or whose motivation is basically recreational. Artists whose works have been previously accepted into the Advanced Division are not eligible for the Amateur Division.
